

Best Management Practice	Guidelines
Disaster Lagoon Management Incentive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can pay for work done to decrease lagoon levels from September 14 through March 1. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Must apply or transport waste to sites that are approved emergency application/treatment sites that are NOT part of the generator operations' existing waste utilization plan; OR ○ Apply on existing sites by a CONTRACTOR using a method that will permit more timely application of lagoon liquid than the producer's normal application methods. • Once liquid is applied/transported and paid, the contract is complete. • No need for receipts. • Can be used in conjunction with the Disaster Winter Forage Crop Incentive and Disaster Pasture Renovation Practices. • Contract in CS2 under FLM.
Disaster Winter Forage Crop Incentive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can pay \$20 per acre for any planting done since September 14 through the planting deadline for the seed planted. • Payment will be made when the crop has emerged with a suitable stand. • Once cover established and paid, the contract is complete. • No need for receipts. • Can be used in conjunction with the Disaster Lagoon Management Incentive and Disaster Pasture Renovation Practices. • Contract in CS2 under FWF.
Disaster Pasture Renovation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can pay for renovations on pastureland and sprayfields done from September 14 on. Payment is 75% of actual costs up to a maximum of \$225/acre at 75% cost share or \$270/acre at 90% cost share. • 10 year contract life. • Need receipts to calculate payment. • Can be used in conjunction with the Disaster Lagoon Management Incentive and Disaster Winter Forage Crop Incentive Practices. • Contract in CS2 under FPR.
