



Kojo's Maths Problems



Can you help Kojo solve these problems?

- 1. On Monday all 6 of my hens had laid 3 eggs each. How many eggs did they lay altogether?
- 2. On Tuesday the hens did even better and each of my 6 hens laid 5 eggs each. How many did I collect on Tuesday?
- 3. On Wednesday each hen laid only 2 eggs. How many did I get from the coup?
- 4. On Thursday only 5 hens laid. Two laid 4 eggs each and the other 2 laid 6 each. How many eggs were laid all together?
- 5. On Friday I found that my hens had amazingly laid 10 eggs each!! How many was I pleased to collect on Friday?
- 6. On Saturday my hens had a rest!!! I took all of my eggs to market. How many eggs did I take?
- 7. I sold half of my eggs and took half home. How many did I sell?
- 8. If I sold each egg for 5 cents. How much money did I make?
- 9. We also sold bundles of wood at market. We sold six bundles at 50 cents each. How much money did we make?
- 10.On Sunday, I bought 6 new hens for my new farm. How many hens do I have now?
- 11.On Sunday afternoon I sat down with my mum and had scrambled eggs. We used 6 eggs! If we had scrambled eggs every day of the week, how many eggs would we need?
- 12. How many eggs boxes would I need to carry the eggs to market? Each box holds 6 eggs.
