Join Small Farm Unit staff Leeanna Bunch and Matt Ball, and Johnny's Selected Seeds representative Blake Thaxton for a workshop using innovative hand tools in the field. Small scale mixed annual vegetable producers will have a chance to view these tools and try them out in person. Tools that will be showcased include: silage tarps, tilter, flame weeders, quick-cut greens harvester, Jang JP-1 seeder, Terratek double wheel hoe, and paperpot transplanter. We will also use specialized long handled tools including the zipper, half moon hoe, stirrup hoe, collinear hoe, broadfork, and CobraHead.
